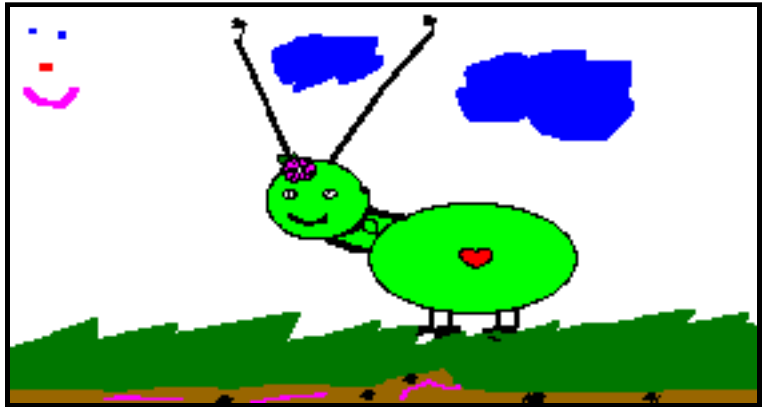


Cricket
