Shake 2000:

The Superintendent has asked all students and staff to participate in a districtwide earthquake preparedness drill which will be held on Thursday, April 27, 2000, at 1:30 p.m. This drill will simulate a 6.8 magnitude earthquake on the Newport-Inglewood fault. Schools have been built to strict building standards and are considered to be among the safest buildings in the community.

The students and staff will participate in the activation of our school's Integrated Safe Schools Plan. The goals of the training drill are to improve our ability to save lives, reduce injuries, and protect property. You are encouraged to participate in this drill. Please be advised that your child will be dismissed at the regular time on this day.

Prior to the drill, please discuss with your child your family's home preparedness plan. Several resources are available to help you prepare. The American Red Cross has outstanding materials, and your own telephone directory has valuable information on first aid, CPR and home preparedness. Should you have any questions, please call our office. We appreciate your concern and will be pleased to answer your questions.

Kindergarten Enrollment

We are continuing with our Kindergarten enrollment and have limited spaces left for the 2000- 2001 school year. In order to enroll in Kindergarten, you must live in our school community attendance area. We will need proof of address with every enrollment packet and will accept a current utility bill with the name of the parent or guardian. If you cannot provide a bill, you must fill out a form obtained from our office. Pursuant to the current law, all new Kindergarten enrollees must be (5) years of age on or before December 2, 2000. We will need proof of age and will accept a Birth Certificate, Passport, Baptism Certificate or a Hospital Certificate of Birth. If you have any friends, relatives or neighbors who live in our school attendance area and are ready to start in Kindergarten for the coming school year, please let them know so that they can enroll as soon as possible before all the seats have been filled.

Jump Rope for Heart

Students at Alexandria and across the country are participating in Jump Rope for Heart activities. During this event, which will take place on Wednesday, May 24, 2000, the students will be jumping for fun and raising money for the American Heart Association. The monies raised will help people suffering from heart disease and stroke. We will be needing parent volunteers before, during and after the event to assist with the activities on the yard. Safe Moves
